## Virtual Book Pumpkin Decorating Contest



Dear Parents, Students, and Teachers,

This year, the library is getting into the fall spirit by having a virtual pumpkin decorating contest for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade students. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade students and staff are invited to decorate a pumpkin like their favorite book character wearing a mask. It's easy and fun for the whole family! Students and staff must post their pictures onto the Classkick entry form by October 29th at noon.

### Contest Rules:

1. ABSOLUTELY NO CARVED PUMPKINS! We don't want a child handling a knife or carving tools. Carved pumpkins will not be entered into the contest. To decorate you can use paper, glue, paint, markers, pipe cleaners, fabric, or other craft items.
2. Pumpkins should represent a favorite book character in an elementary book that is wearing a mask. On the entry form(classkick document), you must write the title and author of the book. **\*\*I would recommend getting the book information first before even starting to decorate the pumpkin. \*\***
3. This is a home project and pumpkins should be done mostly by students with a little assistance from an adult. .
4. Judging will be conducted by a panel of judges.

### Entering Pumpkins

1. Students will click on the Pumpkin Decorating Contest link in Clever
2. Type in your name (first, last) and then press continue
3. Fill out the entry form information
4. Add pictures (1 or 2) by using the camera button at the top of the Classkick assignment **\*All pumpkins must be wearing a mask\***
