All you have to do is dial 2-1-1 or call 330-393-1565. This hotline is a 24-hour service for all the residents of Trumbull County.

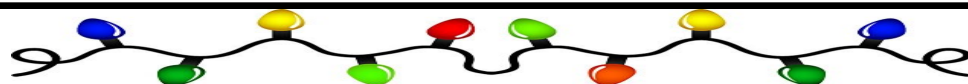
## Available On-line Resources

- ◆ **Progressbook:** on-line gradebook in which both students & parents can have an account. The link to Progressbook is available on the district website (click on the icon). See the guidance page of the Harding website to request login information
- ◆ **Fuel Ed:** credit recovery website. There is a link now available on the district webpage
- ◆ **Naviance:** is career planning website in which all students have an account

## Work Keys Assessment for the Class of 2018

Students in the Class of 2018 who have not met their testing points are now being offered the option of taking the Work Keys Assessment. This will be given at no cost on December 18th & 20th at Harding, and at a later date in January. Students are automatically going to be scheduled to take this test.

11th: 10.25-15.75 credits

12th: 16+ credits

If your child will be out of school for more than three days, you can request assignments by calling the Guidance Office Ext. 2488 with your child's name, dates of absences, and a medical excuse or have principal approval.
