## Scheduling for the 2018-19 School Year

All current 9th, 10th, & 11th grade students are currently making course selections with their counselor. Please review your child's course selection with them and contact your child's counselor with any concerns that you may have.

## For Students Struggling in Courses

If your child is struggling in any course there are some opportunities available to assist them in raising their grades:

- ◆ There will be tutoring available in the library from 2:45-3:30: Monday & Tuesdays English, Wednesdays & Thursdays Math, Science, & Social Studies
- ◆ The library is also open daily until 3:30 if your child needs to use a computer or have a quiet place to study.
- ◆ There will be targeted intervention for sophomores struggling in core courses and ACT prep for specific sophomores and juniors as well—if you would like your child included in this intervention, please contact their school counselor.
- ◆ A student must pass at least 2 of the 4 grading periods and the final exam to earn credit in a full-year class. If a student fails a course, then they are highly encouraged to attend summer school to ensure graduating on time.

## Finish the Year Strong!

As we are completing the 2017-2018 school year, it is very important that all students:

- ◆ Attend school daily—It is difficult to maintain good grades when absent.
- ◆ Arrive to school on-time.
- ◆ Continue to monitor grades using Progressbook.

# Testing in the Spring of 2018

## CREDIT BREAKDOWN

Confused about your grade level on your schedule? The following credits earned determine the grade level that is assigned on your schedule and report card.

9th: 0-4.75 credits

10th: 5-10 credits

11th: 10.25-15.75 credits

12th: 16+ credits

Testing has expanded as a requirement of the Ohio Department of Education. Your child will receive a detailed schedule of their testing dates through the months of March, April, & May.

- ◆ Students who have been enrolled in high school for three years will be required to take the ACT which is paid for by the state. On March 20th, it is imperative that these students are in school on-time. There are very limited opportunities to make-up this test.
- ◆ EOC/AIR Testing: Students taking English I & II, Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, U.S. History, U.S. Government and any student who has not earned 18 points or lacks a proficient score in any previously attempted test. April 9th-May 15th.
- ◆ December EOC/AIR results will be received the last week of February.
- ◆ Students enrolled in AP courses will test May 7-16.

## HOMEWORK REQUESTS

If your child will be out of school for **more than three days**, you can request assignments by calling the Guidance Office Ext. 2488 with your child's name, dates of absences, and a medical excuse or have principal approval. There will be a 24-hour wait period to allow teachers to prepare materials. The assignments will then be available for pick-up.

## T.C.T.C. Applications for the 2018-19 School Year

Any sophomore student who is planning on attending T.C.T.C. in the 2018-19 school year will need to complete the on-line application. The priority deadline has passed, but students can still apply. ## College Credit Plus 2018-19

Any student interested in taking Dual Enrollment Courses through the College Credit Plus Program should take the following steps:

- ◆ Take the April ACT if not previously taken & complete the Intent Form (required for participation) and return it to the Guidance Office.
- ◆ Sign-up for Remind notifications—sign-up by Texting @wghccp to the number 81010 or sign-up for the app by browsing [rmd.at/wghccp](http://rmd.at/wghccp) & follow the instructions.
- ◆ Applications for each university will be completed in February. If a student has not been in contact and has not returned an intent form—they could miss this opportunity.
