Scheduling for the 2018-19 School Year

All current 9th, 10th, & 11th grade students are currently making course selections with their counselor. Please review your child's course selection with them and contact your child's counselor with any concerns that you may have.

For Students Struggling in Courses

If your child is struggling in any course there are some opportunities available to assist them in raising their grades:

- ٠ There will be tutoring available in the library from 2:45-3:30: Monday & Tuesdays English, Wednesdays & Thursdays Math, Science, & Social Studies
- The library is also open daily until 3:30 if your child needs to use a computer or have a ٠ quiet place to study.
- There will be targeted intervention for sophomores struggling in core courses and ACT prep for specific sophomores and juniors as well—if you would like your child included in this intervention, please contact their school counselor.
- A student must pass at least 2 of the 4 grading periods and the final exam to earn credit in a full-year class. If a student fails a course, then they are highly encouraged to attend summer school to ensure graduating on time.
