The Warren City Schools Foundation 2019 Scholarships

The Warren City Schools Foundation Scholarship Funds, component funds of the Community Foundation of the Mahoning Valley, award scholarships annually to graduating seniors to inspire and enable Warren G. Harding Students to pursue post-secondary education in a university, community college, or trade school.

Scholarships will be awarded at the annual Warren City Schools Foundation Alumni Hall of Fame induction ceremony on May 4, 2019. Recipients are strongly encouraged to attend this event.

General Scholarships:

- All graduating seniors are eligible and encouraged to apply for General Scholarships, regardless of GPA.
- Scholarships are awarded annually to deserving students, often under names recognizing alumni and past staff members.

Designated Scholarships:

- Scholarships reserved for graduating seniors meeting specific criteria, such as athletic participation or intended area of study.
- Students should review the below guidelines to determine their eligibility before applying for these specific scholarships.
- Students should indicate

Frank Bubba Scholarship: Awarded to a **senior basketball player.** This scholarship was established in memory of the long-time Warren City Schools teacher and basketball coach upon his death in 2002.

The Dr. John O. and Mary Alice Vlad Scholarship: Awarded to **students who demonstrate excellence in scholarship, music and athletics**. John and Mary Alice graduated from WGH in 1952. They both graduated from Hiram College. John graduated from the Ohio State University Medical School; Mary Alice was a teacher for several years.

C. Robert Wyndham and Fred Kubli, Jr. Scholarship: Awarded to students who reside in property owned or operated by the Trumbull Metropolitan Housing Authority. Eligible students write an essay that addresses the theme: "If I could change the world, I would . . . "

Carl and Barbara Ann Zoba Scholarship: Awarded to women who have been successful in completing high school while overcoming serious difficulties that have affected their educational program, demonstrating ability and commitment to further their education. The scholarship was founded by David Zoba (HOF class of 2007) and Joy Mistele, to honor their mother, Barbara Ann Zoba.

The Warren Promise Scholarship Program has been established to award WGH students with a GPA of 3.75 or higher who have plans to attend a post-secondary at least one scholarship.
