- Congratulations to the Class of 2020—we are proud of you and grateful that you are now part of the Warren City Schools Alumni.
- Seniors continuing their education next year should request a final transcript in Naviance. If the student is also receiving an athletic scholarship, they need to request a transcript from the NCAA Clearinghouse as well.
- If a senior completed coursework with Eastern Gateway Community College, Youngstown State University, and/or Kent State University while in high school, they will need to request a transcript be sent to the university that they are attending in the fall. This is completed on each university's website.
- Diploma pick-up occurred on May 28 & 29. Any diplomas not picked up will be mailed in the near future.
