Spring End of Course Testing

The state required End of Course testing will begin on March 25. The schedule for each class is listed on the next page. Students should anticipate being in class for the morning during testing. It is recommended that they dress comfortably within dress code. Student may use their own device or a school computer in testing. Students will receive an individualized testing schedule in their Raider Day as well.

Students should anticipate the following:

- Students will report to their first period for attendance and then be dismissed to testing.
- Your pass will have a location for testing. Some students are testing in a lab, some students are testing in a classroom. You are encouraged to bring your laptop and charger.
- Students may not bring electronics other than your laptop into the testing room (cell phones & smartwatches)—they will be asked to give any electronics to the proctor. Violation of this rule can result in a suspension & cancelling of your test score(s).
- Students may use headphones on all tests except the ELA test. We will have headphones available if your child chooses to use them. Students may use their own headphones or earbuds if you prefer, but they are not permitted to listen to anything but the test.

Class of 2024 Sophomore Updates from Ms. Mizik

WGH's sophomores have been having thoughtful conversations as we talk through long term goals and post-secondary planning. Students are looking at the courses they have requested for next year and making the necessary adjustments. We want to choose courses carefully to ensure that students earn Industry Recognized Credentials for the workplace or have the required coursework and GPA for admittance to the trade school or college/university of their choice.

Each student in the Class of 2024 will meet with me individually to discuss his/her plans and how to begin making a plan (for those who are still undecided). These are big decisions, and I am here to help!

This spring students will take the ELA II End of Course exam, of which a score of 684 is required to graduate. We also will be taking the US History exam. Students who pass the US History exam AND the US Government exam next year will earn the Citizenship Seal toward graduation. Many of our students will also be taking the Geometry End of Course exam, which is required by the US Dept of Education.
