Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) General Information to Families March 9, 2020

WCS Families:

Enclosed in this mailing are two documents with general information regarding Coronavirus Disease 2019, known commonly as COVID-19 that has been provided to me and other local Superintendents through the Trumbull County Health Department for distribution to our families. At the time of this mailing I want to confirm that there are currently no cases of COVID-19 in Trumbull County and/or the surrounding areas and this information is being sent out as precautionary and informative for your review.

We are asking that you review both pages of information and note the link provided by the State of Ohio available to you for more information and updates. This information, and continued updated information regarding COVID-19 will be on our district web page (warrencityschools.org) for as long as updates continue to be available to us by the Trumbull County Health Department.

In Warren City Schools we are continuing our efforts to provide your child's education in a clean and sanitized environment. In addition to routine cleaning, additional time and effort has been dedicated to disinfecting common areas oftentimes frequented by students. Traditional cleaning is always good; however, on a regular routine schedule we have been utilizing electrostatic sprayers to further disinfect surfaces in classrooms and other student centered areas. Additionally, our nurses from Akron Children's Hospital are working to encourage and teach our youngest learners the importance and proper way for hand washing, which according to guidance from health officials is one of the best ways to prevent the spread of this and other common viruses.
