

2020-2021 OIP 1 Year Plan

The Warren City School District's OIP 3 Year Plan (2017-2020), both academic and climate goals were carried over during the 2020-2021 school year due to the pandemic. The work throughout the District continues to focus on strategies identified within the plan.

Academic Goal:

By 2020 students of Warren City Schools will demonstrate achievement and progress toward becoming college and career ready as evidenced by the local report card. *Due to the pandemic, for the 2020-2021 school year the District will use NWEA Map, PSAT, SAT and any portion of the LRC made available.*

- Increase yearly in percent proficient in each reading and math grades 3-8, Algebra 1 and Geometry, and Social Studies and Science in the specific tested grade levels for these contents.
- Yearly reduction in the achievement gap for reading and mathematics for Economically Disadvantaged, SWD,
 AA, and Multi-racial.
- Overall Value Added met or above, yearly.
- Yearly increase in the PI
- Grade of C or better, yearly, for the district in K-3 Literacy and Graduation.

Strategy 1

All teachers PK-12 will implement the District's adopted core instructional frameworks aligned to the Standards to engage all learners in rigorous instruction.

Strategy 2

Teachers will make data based decisions to inform instruction to meet the needs of learners.

Strategy 3

Teachers will utilize proactive systems of intervention and support to meet the needs of ALL learners.

Climate Goal:

Develop a safe, supportive, and caring school environment for all learners by enhancing positive relationships, staff to staff and adults to students, resulting in a 20% increase in positive climate ratings by students and staff from September 2017 to May 2020. Due to the pandemic, the focus has shifted to engaging all learners whether remote or in person instruction as measured by multiple engagement factors, while maintaining a critical focus on social and emotional well-being of students and staff.

<u>Strategy 1</u>: The District create classrooms and environments that support the Social and Emotional well-being of students.

- Daily time identified for explicit SEL instruction around CASEL's five core competencies
- Weekly professional development for adults through lens of SEL
- Implementation of PBIS PK-12
- Transition Plans for students entering the District
